



For over four decades, the Cancer Association of Spartanburg and Cherokee Counties, Inc. has been dedicated to responding to the needs of clients in our community. These are our friends, our associates, our neighbors, and our families. Their cancers are different but they all have one thing in common: they experienced the generous, loving support of our organization.

Our ability to respond to our clients' needs is all thanks to the generous support of our donors and partners, and the tireless efforts of our staff, Board of Directors and volunteers. Together we are helping our clients live better, healthier lives.

In 2010 we sought opportunities to enhance our client services and broaden community outreach programs. This year we reached over 933 clients and provided nearly 30,000 services. We provided critical supplies to cancer patients including nutritional supplements, bras & breast prostheses, ostomy & home care supplies, wigs and toiletry items. We offered financial assistance for treatment transportation and medications, and loaned hospital equipment.

Furthermore, we held health fairs and gave personal presentations to community clubs, businesses and churches. We offered free screenings, smoking cessation classes, and an extensive library of literature. We created a cooking workshop tailored to the needs and challenges faced by cancer patients. We designed a program for survivors of breast cancer, to help them heal and prepare for life after cancer. Just as importantly, we offered emotional support to those who truly needed it.

If not for the Cancer Association, programs and services like these would otherwise be unavailable to many of our clients.

CANCER SUPPORT SERVICES

Providing information to clients and their advocates is paramount to helping them understand their situations and make the best choices about their care. Our extensive library offers educational materials in a variety of mediums from audio recordings to books, to pamphlets and internet access for cancer and health-related searches.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Increasing awareness and educating our community about cancer are an important part of our mission. We offer classes, health fairs and speaking engagements in a variety of locations to reach as many members of our community as possible.

COUNSELING

Connecting patients and their loved ones with professionals, trained to help them manage the stresses of a positive diagnosis is another way we ease the burdens of our clients. Our network of relationships and experience with previous clients makes us uniquely able to address a wide variety of situations.

NUTRITIONAL SUPPLEMENTS

Staying nutritionally fortified is an important part of fighting cancer. The Cancer Association offers cases of nutritional supplements at no cost to clients.

CANCER SCREENINGS

Early detection is critical in the fight against cancer. Free screenings are one way we are helping to save lives. 2010 Results: 133 Screenings

MEDICAL SUPPLIES

We offer a variety of home care supplies such as bed pads, mouth swabs, hospital gowns, and ostomy supplies at no cost to our clients.

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

We have a medical equipment room from which we lend much-needed equipment for home use. Wheelchairs and walkers, hospital beds and commodes, shower seats and crutches are all on site and available at no charge. We provide wigs, hats, turbans, breast prostheses, and mastectomy bras at no charge to our clients.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Relieving some of the burden of cost for cancer medication and transportation to and from cancer treatments can be an enormous help to our clients. The costs associated with cancer treatment can be staggering. We help patients get the care they need with gas cards and financial allocations to ease their stress and help them stay focused on getting well.

2010 Results: 244 Transportation allocations given 91 Prescription allocations granted

GIFTS IN KIND CENTER

In 2009, the United Way of the Piedmont opened a "Gifts in Kind Center", which allows non-profits to join for an annual membership charge. For a weekly fee, representatives from the Cancer Association shop weekly for various household items, from toilet paper to cleaning supplies to stock our center. In turn, once a month clients are able to "shop" at the Cancer Association office for the items they need.

SLICE OF LIFE WORKSHOP

This year, in response to the nutritional challenges faced by cancer survivors and their families, we partnered with the Spartanburg Regional Foundation and the Pelham Batesville Fire Department to hold our first Slice of Life free nutrition and cooking workshop.

The workshop was based on two cookbooks: The Cancer Lifeline Cookbook and Betty Crocker's Living with Cancer Cook Book, copies of which were given to attendees.

We created a free *Mutrition* workshop designed to ease symptoms, calm minds and empower patients and their caregivers.

Chef Tom Buice & Registered Dietician Cathy Zwilling from the Gibbs Cancer Center partnered to create an entertaining and informative presentation. Guests watched the preparation of delicious recipes like Dijon Chicken and Easy Brown Bread, while learning helpful tips for easing preparation and understanding the role of nutrition in the healing process. All of the guests were given a frozen meal to enjoy later.

The symptoms and side effects of cancer and its treatments can ravage the body and overwhelm the mind, leaving the spirit frail. With this workshop, patients and their guests were given valuable tools to ease their symptoms and calm their minds, leaving their spirits strong.

Bosom Buddies Survivors Academy

Cancer has a way of shrinking a patient's world. Life becomes about battle and survival. Women who emerge victorious often find themselves exhausted physically and spiritually and underprepared to step back into life as they knew it. For this reason, we created the Bosom

Buddies Survivors Academy, a free 12-week wellness program for breast cancer survivors.

Weekly classes were held at ReGenesis Health Care in Gaffney and lead by Kim Evans, Breast Health Navigator. Each class was devoted to a proven method of managing stress and promoting wellbeing. From exercise and nutrition, to yoga and spirituality, graduates of Bosom Buddies Survivors Academy were given tools to heal, rejoice and renew themselves for life after cancer.

PROSTATE SCREENINGS

With that in mind, the Cancer Association and ReGenesis Health Care successfully partnered for the third year to provide life saving



About 1 man in 6 will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during his lifetime. More than 2 million men in the United States who have been diagnosed with prostate cancer at some point are still alive today.

Cancer of the prostate gland, after lung cancer, is the most widespread version of the disease suffered by men. Relatively easy to cure if caught in its early stages; it generally strikes men in their mid-fifties and up. One of the best cures for prostate cancer is early detection.



free Digital Rectal Exams & Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) blood work to residents of Spartanburg and Cherokee counties. The event was in September at the Gaffney office of ReGenesis Health Care and twenty-two men were screened.



Cherokee County is the number one county in South Carolina for late stage breast cancer diagnosis.

We partnered to Educate, support and celebrate with our community.




🐔 In the Pink Health Fair

In October 2010, 16 vendors joined together in partnership with Wal-Mart, the Cherokee County Late Stage Breast Cancer Task Force and the Cancer Association in a Wal-Mart store in Gaffney to create a health fair where the community could gather in a fun-filled atmosphere and learn about their own health and the services available to them in their area.

Vendors offered free services such as flu shots, cholesterol and blood pressure screenings, eye screenings and opportunities to sign up for free mammograms. To keep things light and encourage participation, door prizes were awarded every thirty minutes, while entertainment and music were provided by Benard Pitts of Restoration Church.

The highlight of the day was the ribbon-cutting event for the New Bearden-Josey Center for Breast Health Mobile Mammography Van. This is a wonderful tool that will enable us to reach even more women and save more lives in Spartanburg and Cherokee Counties.
